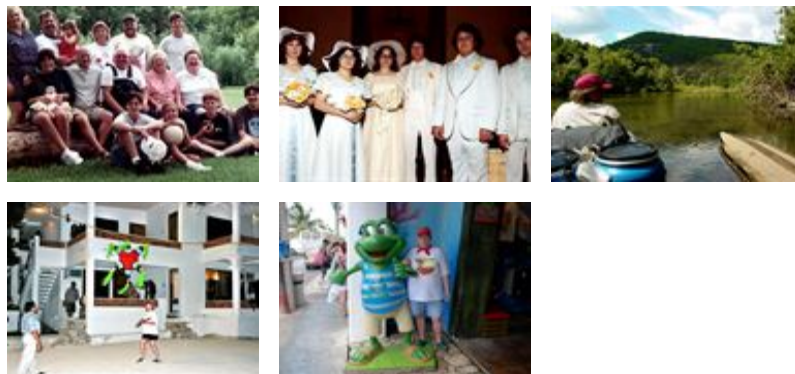

One of my Favorite memories, was going with Gary and Anita to the Buffalo River, for a 2-day canoe trip(kids included). It was Mother's Day weekend, in 1988 I believe. She warned me Not to wear a two-piece swimsuit because I would get baked by the sun. Of course, I thought I would be fine and wore a two-piece anyway. By the end of the second day, I was so sun burned, and in so much pain, I could barely even walk. The next morning, I wore the loosest jeans I owned, so they wouldn't rub against my burned legs. I opened the door to take my daughter to school, and found a note and a gallon jug of vinegar on my front porch. The note said, "The vinegar is suppose to ease the pain of the sunburn by drawing out the heat." That is the kind of person Anita was to me. She went out of her way, to go buy that and deliver it before I left the house in the morning. Remember, we had gotten back fairly late the night before. She was so unselfish, loving, and was always a giver, not a taker. She was a once-in-a-lifetime, kind of friend. I will Never forget all the great times we shared.
