



Antonio Pacheco Garcia

November 9, 1942 - June 10, 2025

Antonio P. Garcia, 82, of Kansas City, Kansas, passed away peacefully on June 10, 2025. Born on November 9, 1942, in Juarez, Mexico, Antonio was the son of Antonio Garcia and Asuncion Pacheco. He moved to the United States in 1961 and became a U.S. citizen in 1976, proudly embracing his new country while honoring his Mexican heritage.

On February 5, 1963, Antonio married the love of his life Alice. Together they built a beautiful life and shared 62 years of unwavering devotion. Antonio worked as a laborer for BNSF Railway for 35 years, retiring with pride and dedication. He was a man of deep faith and service, serving as a Eucharistic minister and cursillista at St. John the Evangelist Church. He also generously gave his time to Cancer Action, volunteering to make bed pads for those in need. A self-taught barber since the age of 12, Antonio cut hair for 66 years – not just as a trade, but as a way to connect with his family, friends, and community. He was a passionate coach, especially when it came to his children's softball teams, and an enthusiastic sports fan who never missed a chance to cheer on the Kansas City Chiefs, Royals, and KU Jayhawks. However, his greatest joy came from watching his grandchildren grow and play sports. Antonio loved to dance, sing, and bowl, and he lived life with heart, humor, and humility.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Antonio Garcia and Asuncion

Pacheco; brothers Mario Andy, and Johnny Garcia; infant daughter Alice Garcia; and infant son Jose Antonio Garcia. Antonio leaves behind his beloved wife, Alice; sons Tony Garcia (Jodie), Joe Garcia, Robert Garcia (Elaine), and Steven Garcia (Raegan); and grandchildren Hannah and Joseph Garcia; Jessica Everhart (Randy), Jacque Todd (Landon), Nick Herdman, Josh Herdman, and Hannah Garcia; Emilio, Bianca, Vincent, and Leila Garcia; Ledger, O'Hara, and Lofton Garcia; as well as great-grandchildren Lincoln and Violet Todd.
