Billie Frances Rice Mosley, 102 1/2 years, was born in New Boston, OH on September 11, 1923. She was preceded in death by her spouse Elmer Ray Mosley (January 30, 2002); her parents Alonzo & Mayme Rice; a baby sister Ilo Jane Rice; sister Ida Mae Adams Cundy; and brothers Jerry Ogden Grantland Rice and Larry Donald Stuart Rice. She was married to Elmer R Mosley and they were blessed with five children. They moved to several states during the war years: Maryland, Michigan, Texas and Missouri, before moving to Kansas City, Kansas in 1950. Billie accepted Christ as her personal Savior in 1957 at Springvale Bible Church. She was also a member of the Ruby Ave Baptist Church from 1960 until its closing in 2001, she then moved her membership to Faith Temple Church in 2002.

Billie was employed by the Kansas City, Kansas Recreation Department from 1968 until 1974, where she directed several playgrounds in the summer. During the school months, she directed preschool classes at Bell Recreation Center. In 1975, she was employed as a director for La Petite Preschool.

After a battle with breast cancer, she was employed by Bethany Medical Center in 1977 where she worked as a ward clerk in day surgery. After five years in this position, she moved to the admitting office as a clerk. She retired in 1999. She loved children and teaching. At BMC, greeting the patients and making them comfortable was a pleasure for her; which is why she worked

until she was 75 years of age. She enjoyed friends, growing flowers, art museums and traveling with her family.

After caring for her husband, she shared her time with her children, grandchildren, and great grandies. She leaves behind three loving daughters: Jackie Gochenour, Sandra Davison, and Cindy Seers, two loving sons: James Mosley and Elmer Mosley Jr., as well as eleven grandchildren, thirteen great grandies and 20 great-great grandies.
