Dagoberto "Alberto" Galván LMV, 60, falleció jueves, 01 de diciembre de 2016 en KU Medical Center.

At age 11 he left school to begin working in the fields to help support his family as many children did during this time. He would work in many places throughout Texas and areas to the north and would tell us stories of the hardships he endured to ensure his family had what they needed. This work ethic remained with him throughout his life as he worked many hours in cold winter weather to give us all he could, whether it was as a mechanic or on the road as a nursery owner in Texas.

His eventual move north also set him on his path towards a musical career as one of the lead vocalists and guitarists with his brothers and friends as LOS BRONCOS del NORTE. They traveled the country touring with some of the most prominent Mexican artists and bands of the Southwest region and Mexico at the time. He made countless friends through the years and treated everyone with respect. Many a friend knew they could count on "Alberto" to assist whenever they needed him.

He was a man who loved his family and always greeted you with a firm handshake or a strong hug. He will always be remembered by those that knew him, but especially his grandchildren who, even with having had less time with him, loved and admired him as much as those who were blessed to have had him much longer.

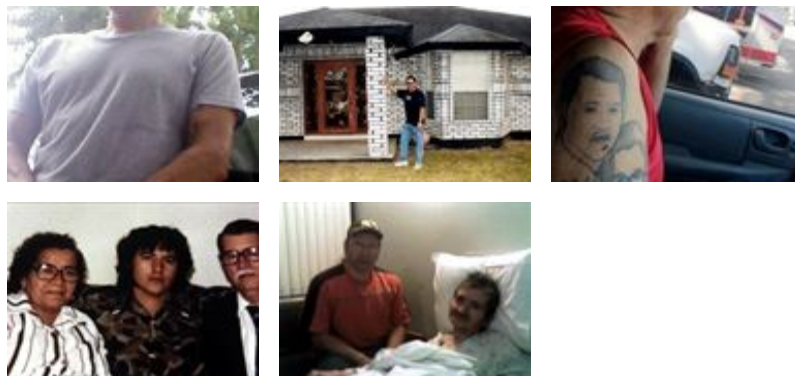
