David was a lifetime resident of Wyandotte County, a Graduate of Washington High School and attended Kansas University. In his youth, Dave was a Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Certified Lifeguard and Red Cross Swimming instructor, specializing in teaching infants to swim. Dave worked for Wyandotte Swim Club as office manager and Head Lifeguard, Lens Crafter, Rent-a-Center, Vanguard Airlines, and in Real Estate sales with his mother. For the last eleven and a half years David worked for the Social Security Administration, Debt Management Division. He was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Basehor. David was an amazing man. In 2011 he was diagnosed with the loss of both kidneys and placed on KU's kidney transplant list. David was a devout follower of Jesus Christ, focusing on him every step of the way. He is survived by his parents, Tom and Phyllis Mamie-three brothers and two sister-in-laws - Tom Mamie Jr, Michael and Barbara Mamie, and Chris and Shelly Mamie all of Kansas City, Kansas-two Aunts and Uncles-Karen and
