Delores Jean Carmel-Moyer was born on June 30, 1926, in the home of her parents, Lorenzo John Carmel (Caramellino) and Leota (Spence) Carmel, of Chicopee, KS. Delores passed away on May 1, 2013, at Lawrence Memorial Hospital of heart failure. Delores was involved with her seven children through church, school PTA, Brownie and Girl Scout Leader, Cub Scout Den Leader, Boy Scout activities and getting her children to all of the many functions they were all involved in as a stay at home mom.
