



Doris "Jeannie" Snapp

April 27, 1960 - January 2, 2021

Doris Jean Snapp, 60, died on January 2, 2021 with her husband of 41 years, Ronald Snapp, by her side. Jeannie, as she was known by family and friends, was born on April 27, 1960 in Kansas City, KS to Doris Huntley (now Crowder) and Earl Huntley. She grew up in Kansas City, Kansas with her two sisters, Glenna Ray and Betty Choate, her brother Earl Huntley, her cousin Alice Gilmore, her mom Doris, and her stepfather Robert Crowder. Both Earl and Robert preceded her in death.

Jeannie had many jobs from t-shirt printing at Artex to dispatcher for Coca-Cola. She was a dedicated employee, but work was never as important to her as people.

Jeannie loved to love people. She was a loving and devoted mother of David Snapp and Jennifer Snapp Lafountain and proud grandmother of Mason McGlasson all of whom were the light of her life. One of her favorite Bible stories was Mark 10: 13-16. "People were bringing little children to Jesus to have him touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said to them, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I tell you the truth, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." And he took the children in his arms, put his hands on them and blessed them."

Jeannie lived out this Bible story for many years where she was also known as Aunt Jeannie by many who may or may not have been related to her. Aunt Jeannie's house was always open for any who needed a place to stay, a meal to eat or even a good ass chewing. She would then make sure that each child knew God loved them and would take them to church the next morning.

Jeannie is survived by her husband Ron, her daughter Jennifer, her son David, her daughter-in-law Jennifer and grandson Mason. She is also survived by her mother, Doris, her sisters Glenna and Betty and numerous nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews, cousins and so many more that have fond memories of her.

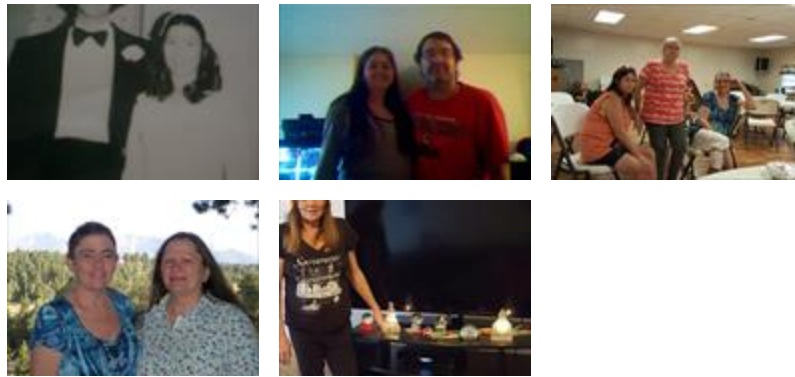
