



Dorothy "Dot" Barrett

May 8, 1928 - January 5, 2024

Dorothy "Dot" (Janes) Barrett, aged 95, peacefully passed away on Friday, January 5, 2024. Born on May 8, 1928, in Nebraska City, Nebraska, she was the eldest of three children to Walter and Juanita Janes. Dot graduated from Argentine High School in the class of 1946. Her first marriage was to Robert Bauer, with whom she had two children, Sandy and Debbie. She later married John Barrett, and together they had one child, Beth. Dot dedicated 15 years of her career to the Social Security Administration as a Benefit's Authorizer, retiring in 1987.

A lifelong member of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), Dot was actively involved in Disciple Women's Ministries. Known for her love of games, she maintained a cherished tradition of playing games with her family every Friday night for many years. Additionally, Dot found joy in crocheting afghans for cancer action. A devoted fan of the Kansas City Royals throughout her life, she never missed a game, meticulously journaling the scores for many years. Dot is preceded in death by her husband of 49 years, John Barrett; first husband, Robert Bauer; and sibling Walter "Clyde" Janes. She is survived by three daughters: Sandy Allen (Mike), Debbie Morche (Dennis) and Beth McCullough (Merle); sister, Velma Abbott; seven grandchildren; fourteen great grandchildren (with one on the way); and eight great-great-grandchildren.
