



## Dr. Elmer W. Sharp

May 11, 1945 - September 17, 2024

Dr. Elmer W. Sharp, 79, of Kansas City, KS, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, September 17, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. Elmer was born on May 11, 1945, in Miami, OK. He graduated from Argentine High School in 1963 and continued his education while working at Santa Fe Railroad, eventually earning his Chiropractic degree from Cleveland Chiropractic College in 1968—the same year his daughter was born. Elmer was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Bonnie Sharp; his parents, Elmer Sharp and Opal Niday-Sharp; and his brother, Leroy Sharp.
