Esperanza Rangel Amayo, 83, of Kansas City KS, passed away Monday March 21, 2011, at the home. Mrs. Amayo was born March 16, 1928 in Turner, Kansas. She graduated from 8th grade in May 1942. Her lifelong passion was beautiful and eloquent writing. The KC Star Parade Magazine honored her as the Winner of the "Tell America's Story" contest in 2006. She has documented Hispanic tragedies and triumphs for almost 50 years. She inspired the younger generation to discover the history that happened in their own backyards in Argentine. She fought tirelessly and through her efforts and contributions the 2003 unanimous vote of the KCK Board of Education named the Argentine Middle School auditorium the "Saturnino Alvarado Auditorium", which led to his induction into the Mid-America Education Hall of Fame. She went before the Unified Government Board of Commissioners to rededicate the Argentine Community Center in honor of Joe Amayo. December 2008 the Mayor was by her side for the unveiling of the Joe E. Amayo Sr. Argentine Community Center dedication plaque. She will be missed by family and friends. Her memory will live forever in her writings and stories she left behind. She is preceded in death by her parents, brother, and her husband Lupe Amayo of 59 Years. She is survived by her seven children Kathy Amayo Metcalf, David Amayo, Michael Amayo, Linda Green, Susan Marron, Rita Amayo, Louis Amayo, her daughter-in-law Cindy Amayo, her three son-in-laws Bill Metcalf, David Green, David Marron, her sixteen grandchildren, her twenty-three great grandchildren, her sister Lola Vargas, her three brothers
