Ethel (Kasiner) Parrett, 98, went to meet her Lord and Savior on June 12, 2021. Ethel was born in Kinta, Oklahoma to James and Rose Kasiner on June 1, 1923. She married Manuel D. Fletcher in 1943 and a daughter, Connie (Williams) was born in 1944. By 1945 they had moved to the Kansas City, Kansas area where their second daughter, Linda (Tavis) was born. Ethel remained in the Kansas City area for the remainder of her life. She accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her personal savior in 1959 while attending Trinity Baptist Church. She remained an active and faithful church member from that time forward. Ethel was preceded in death by Manuel in 1986. She was also preceded in death by her brother Dewey (Dutch) Kasiner and sisters Florence Woods and Edna Warren. Along with her daughters and son-in-law Jim Tavis, Ethel leaves 7 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren, and 19 great-great-grandchildren. In July of 2003, she was contacted by Ted Parrett, whom she had known 60 years earlier. They were married in September of that same year. She had always said that she would never marry again, but Ted easily changed her mind. He made her life full and happy and she thanked God for bringing them together.
