Evelyn Louise Tygart (Coombs), “Evie” 80, of Kansas City, KS, passed away on Thursday September 1, 2022, surrounded by family at The University of Kansas Medical Center. She was born August 12, 1942, in Glenwood Springs, Colorado.

As a young girl, Evie often hunted deer and elk with her father on Storm King Mountain. She graduated from New Castle High School where she was known as one of the best baton twirlers. She soon made her way to Kansas City and became a travel agent and met her husband, John in 1975. They enjoyed traveling throughout Europe and several Caribbean islands then soon after married on May 12, 1978. Having never skied while growing up in Colorado, she was excited to join the Kansas City Ski Club and finally take it up. In 1978 she qualified for the World Cup in Downhill Slalom which could have led her to the Olympics, though she was unable to participate as she found she was expecting their first child, Kenny. After having her second son, Danny, she wanted to instill the value of community service and as a family they would often volunteer at Franklin Center. She also loved interacting with patients, and tried to spark joy in their life, in her long career at Family Health Care. Evie enjoyed raising her sons and seeing them become parents, and she was extremely proud of her grandchildren. To know Evie, was to love her.
