He is the twelfth of thirteen siblings, eleven of whom have preceded him in death. He leaves his wife, Phyllis, two sons, Clinton of Grandview, Missouri, and Alan of the home and a daughter Marsha of Merriam, Kansas.

Floyd built two beautiful homes for his wife and family. The first constructed of custom cut native stone located in Kansas City where he lived out his life surrounded by his family. The second house was a beautiful glass front A-Frame in Connecticut that he pre-built here in Kansas City. The feat of planning and the mastery of how to build a home of this magnitude remotely was amazing and is a testament to his true ingenuity.

His favorite farewell was "Let me know if I can help you." Originally, he was a carpenter and he loved to build and fix things for people. We often fondly called him the "Master of Overbuild. " If he built it you knew it would last.

Floyd was made of grit and determination. He knew he had to build a good life for his wife and family and no one else could do it for him. He succeeded in

doing exactly that. Hard work was not a problem—he did what he had to do even when it seemed impossible. He found a way to make it happen and we were the fortunate ones to share in his life.

He will always be missed and fondly remembered for the fine man he was.
