61. He was a part of the Teamsters Local Union 41 for 34 years. He was proud of doing what he loved as a truck driver for Missouri Pacific Railroad and a farmer for all of his life. He also was a vivid bowler.

Frank was raised being blessed to be an American. He appreciated the American way of life due to his parents coming directly from Belgium. Frank will be dearly missed. His smile and sense of humor brought joy to everyone he surrounded.

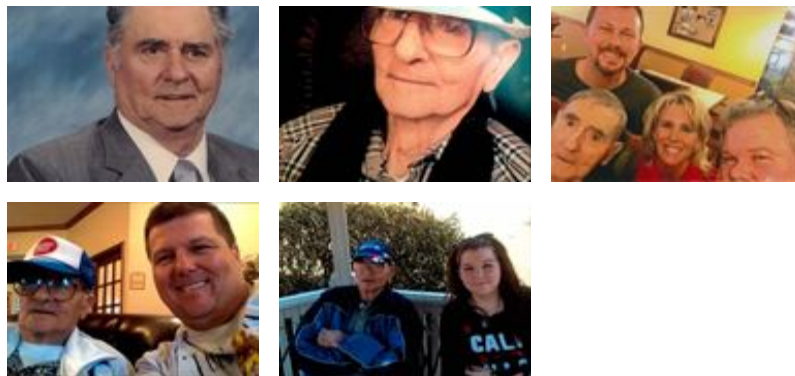
