October 3, 1933 - November 7, 2021

Frank Magana, 88, of Kansas City KS, passed away November 7, 2021. He was born in Kanopolis, KS to Jesus and Sara Magana on October 3, 1933. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps 1953-56, attaining the rank of Sergeant, and then attended Ft. Hays State College. After graduation, Frank taught high school for one year in Sharon Springs and from 1961-68 at Washington High School in KCK before becoming a field representative for the Head Start program.
