Frederick F. "Fred" "Pinky" Jenkins, of Kansas City, KS, passed away on Monday, May 23, 2016 at the St. Luke's Hospice House in Kansas City, MO at the age of 92. Fred was born the son of Harley and Wilma (Acton) Jenkins on September 14, 1923. Fred was born in Colorado. While in Colorado, he was a brick layer and builder. After leaving Colorado, Fred and his wife, Darlys settled in Turner, Kansas. He was employed by Lock Joint & Interpace for 40 years and worked in concrete developments and construction. Throughout his life, Fred was part of many organizations and clubs in Wyandotte County. Those included volunteering for the Turner Fishing Derby, WyCo-Leavenworth Road Fishing Derby, a member of the Maple Hill Optimist Club, helping with the Turner H.S. for Speech Oratorical, working with the Unified Government of Wyandotte County Elections as a Precinct Judge, WyCO Department of Aging, WyCo Jail working in traffic at the front desk, WyCo baseball leagues, Leavenworth Road Association, Lion's Club, and fishing tournaments for Special Olympics at West Mineral, KS. He was selected to be part of Turner's Walk of Fame which recognizes individuals who have had a lasting impact on the Turner school community. For twenty years, Fred and his wife helped decorate floats for the Pasadena Rose Parade in California. Fred's greatest enjoyment was fishing and he loved his family, friends and people in general. He gave freely of his time and resources in hopes of helping others, and he will be dearly missed by all who knew him. Survivors include his daughter, Wanda Jenkins; son, Don Jenkins of Torrance, CA; three grandchildren,

Jonathan, Beau & Casey Jenkins; one great-granddaughter, Adelynn Mae Jenkins and special friend and cousin, George Acton. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife of 70 years, Darlys Mae Jenkins and a grandson, Toby Wade Freeman.
