Gary Anthony Ibarra, 55, of Kansas City, Kansas passed away in Cancun, Mexico on Wednesday, December 11, 2013. He will be forever remembered as a devoted son, brother, uncle, godfather, cousin and friend. Gary was born September 10, 1958 in Kansas City, Missouri to Jesse Ibarra Sr. and Margarita Ibarra (Castro). He attended Argentine Middle School and graduated from JC Harmon High School, Class of 1977, in Kansas City, KS. He would become server, bartender and eventually manager at Manny's Mexican Restaurante for 30-plus years. More recently he was culinary chef at North Kansas City Hospital.

Gary was caring, dependable, reliable, responsible, fun, and extremely outgoing. More importantly, he stayed with and helped tend to his parents for the majority of his short life, just because he wanted to. He loved to travel, especially with his siblings to Cancun and Cabo San Lucas, Mexico.
