George Males, 93, of Kansas City, KS passed away September 4, 2013. Visitation will be held at Maple Hill Funeral Home, Monday, September 9, 2013 at 10 am. Funeral services will follow at 11 am, interment at Maple Hill Cemetery.

George was a veteran of WWII, serving in the Army/Air Force. After his B-17 was shot down, he was held as a POW in Germany for more than 10 months. He was awarded a Purple Heart and an Air Medal which is awarded to servicemen who have distinguished themselves by meritorious achievement while participating in aerial combat.

As a graduate of Argentine High School, he loved his Argentine community. He always stayed close to his roots. He loved to play tennis. In his early forties, he won the Kansas City, KS city tournament.

He worked most of his adult life at Proctor and Gamble. Before retirement he worked as a Master Machinist. He was a member of the local union. He retired in 1981.

George and his wife, Carol, loved to travel. They spent many fun days on the road with Dot and Duke Gerkovich. They covered the United States, and enjoyed every inch.

George Males was preceded in death by the love of his life, his wife Carol Males; his sister Alice Ehrhart, and his great-granddaughter Mia Johnson.
