Goldie L. Zanatta, 97, passed away Monday afternoon with the comfort of family, August 4, 2025. A daughter, sister, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, she was born on June 4, 1928, in Nebraska City, Nebraska, the daughter of Benjamin and Goldia (Gillespie) Bennett.

She enjoyed a rural Nebraska upbringing before the family moved to the Armourdale area of Kansas City, Kansas. After graduating from Argentine High School, she met Anthony L. "Tony" Zanatta and was married prior to his service in World War II and the Korean War.

After fifty-four years of marriage, her husband passed away in 2003. She continued a self-sufficient and active life, steadfast in her beliefs.
