While serving on the fire department he held several positions within the Local 64 Fire Fighters Union, the State Fire Fighters Council where he lobbied for such bills as Senate Bill #567, relating to certain policemen and firemen pension funds. He was also a member of the Argentine Activities Association and a Mason through the Ben Hur Lodge. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-great father and a true friend to many. He will be greatly missed by all who had the
