Helen Marguerite (Trevor) Miller, 94, of Kansas City, KS passed away May 31, 2017 in Garnett, KS after a brief stay at the Parkview Heights Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. 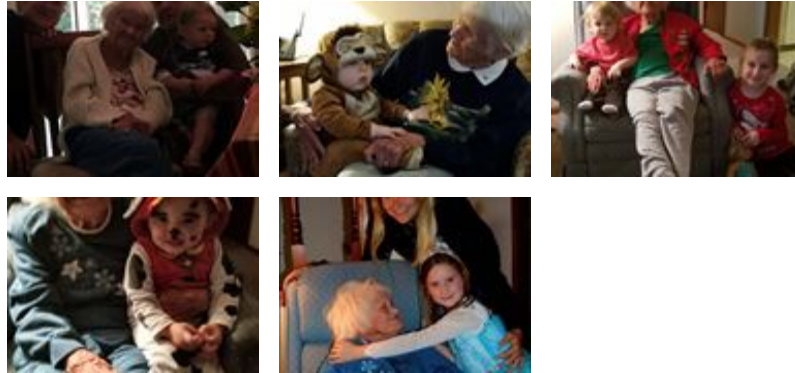

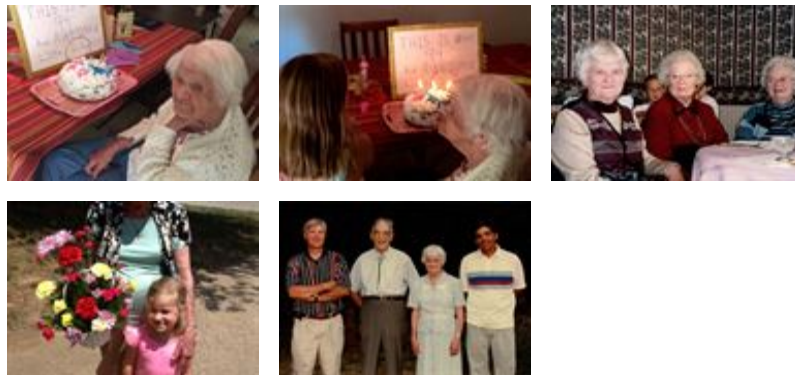
