Born March 19th, 1922 and left this world to join her husband who preceded her in death, John L. Fuller, December 14th 2013. She was 91 years old. Helen grew up in KCK surrounded by 5 older brothers and her parents, Anna (Toth) Uzelac and Milo Uzelac that also preceded her in death. Helen was born with golf in her blood. Her father was a greenskeeper. She began playing at the age of 12 because her parents told her brothers "If you want to play golf, you have to take your sister." Helen received a men's varsity sports letter as a member of the Wyandotte High School men's golf team in 1939. She won 3 consecutive Kansas City Kansas Women's Match Play Championships at the ages of 17, 18 & 19. She was runner up in 2 Kansas State Championships in 1941 and 1949. She also won numerous club championships at Lake Quivira, and other tournaments around the region through the years. Helen was a long time resident of Lake Quivira KS until she moved recently to Overland Park KS. She is survived by 2 sons, John L. Fuller Jr.(wife Delores) of Edmond OK., Daniel M. Fuller(wife Nancy) of Edgerton KS., and 1 daughter, Tamara G. Hoelting (husband Mark) of Shawnee KS. Helen has 9 grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren. She has numerous nieces and nephews, loved by all and will be greatly missed.
