“ Enseñanzas de la Palabra de Dios

¿Hay alguna esperanza para los muertos?

Este artículo le permitirá encontrar en su propia Biblia la respuesta a algunas preguntas que tal vez se haya hecho. Si lo desea, los testigos de Jehová pueden analizar estas preguntas con usted.

1. ¿Qué esperanza hay para los muertos?

Cuando Jesús llegó a Betania, una aldea cercana a Jerusalén, su amigo Lázaro llevaba cuatro días muerto. Acompañado de Marta y María —las hermanas del difunto—, Jesús se dirigió a la tumba, y en poco tiempo se juntó una multitud. ¿Se imagina la alegría de Marta y María al ver que Jesús les devolvía a Lázaro vivo? (Lea Juan 11:20-24, 38-44.)

Marta creía en la resurrección. De hecho, los siervos de Jehová saben desde hace mucho que, en el futuro, Dios resucitará en la Tierra a quienes hayan muerto. (Lea Job 14:14, 15.)

2. ¿Cuál es el estado de los muertos?

Aunque una fuerza de vida, o “espíritu”, mantiene vivos a los seres humanos y a los animales, no somos espíritus que habitan un cuerpo de carne y hueso (Eclesiastés 3:19; Génesis 7:21, 22).

Somos criaturas físicas hechas del polvo (Génesis 2:7; 3:19).

Cuando el cerebro muere, se desvanecen los pensamientos. Por eso Lázaro, después de resucitar, no contó nada sobre su experiencia, ya que los muertos ni sienten ni padecen. (Lea Salmo 146:4; Eclesiastés 9:5, 10.)

Como hemos visto, los muertos no sufren. Así que la enseñanza de que los malos son atormentados tras la muerte es falsa. Esa doctrina difama a Dios, quien detesta la idea de quemar a la gente en el fuego. (Lea Jeremías 7:31.)

3. ¿Se puede hablar con los muertos?

Los muertos no hablan (Salmo 115:17). Sin embargo, los demonios sí pueden hablar a la gente y fingir que son el espíritu del difunto (2 Pedro 2:4). Por ese motivo, Jehová prohíbe tratar de comunicarse con los muertos. (Lea Deuteronomio 18:10, 11.)

4. ¿Quiénes volverán a la vida?

En el nuevo mundo venidero, millones de personas que están en las tumbas volverán a vivir, incluso algunas que practicaron cosas

malas por desconocimiento de las leyes divinas. (Lea Lucas 23:43; Hechos 24:15.)

Las personas que resuciten podrán aprender la verdad sobre Dios y demostrar por su obediencia que tienen fe en Jesús (Revelación [Apocalipsis] 20:11-13). Quienes actúen bien disfrutarán de la vida eterna en la Tierra. En cambio, quienes persistan en hacer lo malo no vivirán para siempre, y su resurrección, tal como dijo Jesús, será “una resurrección de juicio”. (Lea Juan 5:28, 29.)

5. ¿Qué nos enseña sobre Dios la resurrección?

La resurrección solo es posible porque Dios envió a su Hijo a entregar su vida por nosotros. Es una muestra del amor y la bondad inmerecida de Jehová. (Lea Juan 3:16; Romanos 6:23.)

“ Learn From God’s Word

Is There Hope for the Dead?

This article raises questions you may have asked and shows where you can read the answers in your Bible. Jehovah’s Witnesses would be pleased to discuss these answers with you.

1. What is the hope for the dead?

When Jesus arrived at Bethany near Jerusalem, his friend Lazarus had been dead for four days. Jesus went to the grave site with Martha and Mary, the sisters of the deceased man. Soon, a crowd gathered. Can you imagine the joy of Martha and Mary when Jesus raised Lazarus back to life?—Read John 11:20-24, 38-44.

Martha believed that the dead would rise. Faithful servants of Jehovah have long known that in the future, God will resurrect the dead to live on earth again.—Read Job 14:14, 15.

2. What is the condition of the dead?

Although a force of life, or “spirit,” keeps humans and animals alive, we are not spirits that merely inhabit a body of flesh. (Ecclesiastes 3:19; Genesis 7:21, 22) We are physical creatures made out of dust. (Genesis 2:7; 3:19) When our brain dies, our thoughts perish. Thus, after being resurrected, Lazarus said nothing of his experience in death because the dead are unconscious.—Read Psalm 146:4; Ecclesiastes 9:5, 10.

Clearly, the dead cannot suffer. So the teaching that God torments people after death is false. It slanders God. The idea of tormenting people in fire is disgusting to him.—Read Jeremiah 7:31.

3. Can we speak with the dead?

The dead cannot speak. (Psalm 115:17) But when wicked angels speak to people, they may deceptively claim to be the spirit of a dead person. (2 Peter 2:4) Jehovah forbids attempting to speak with the dead.—Read Deuteronomy 18:10, 11.

4. Who will come back to life?

In the coming new world, millions of people who are in the grave will come back to life. Even some who practiced bad things because they did not know Jehovah will be resurrected.—Read Luke 23:43; Acts 24:15.

Resurrected ones will be able to learn the truth about God and to

exercise faith in Jesus by obeying him. (Revelation 20:11-13) Those who come back to life and do good things will be able to enjoy life forever on earth. However, some resurrected ones will continue doing bad things. Their resurrection will turn out to be “a resurrection of judgment.”—Read John 5:28, 29.

5. What does the resurrection tell us about Jehovah?

The resurrection is possible because God sent his Son to give his life for us. So it is an expression of Jehovah’s love and undeserved kindness.—Read John 3:16; Romans 6:23.
