John Allen Bond was born on December 15, 1932 in Purcell, Oklahoma. At the age of eight the family moved to Seligman, Arizona. In 1949 the family moved to the Argentine neighborhood in Kansas City, KS where he graduated from Argentine High School in 1951. Later that year he joined the Navy where he served 4 years and 9 months aboard the heavy cruiser USS Toledo. After leaving the Navy he started working for the Sante Fe Railroad where he worked for 39 years. In 1956 he met the love of his life, Carrol Sue DeBerry. They were married after dating 2 months. The union lasted 61 years. Unable to have children, they adopted Curtis and Lisa. At 85 years of age he was called home to be with his Savior.

John is survived by his wife, Sue; son, Curtis; grandchildren, Danielle Bond, Steven Whitham, John Whitham and Elisha Whitham; great grandchildren, Aydin Redmon, Carson Peck, Zoey Whitmah and Emma Owens; sisters, Bobbie Vavricek and Edith Hinton; many nieces and nephews.

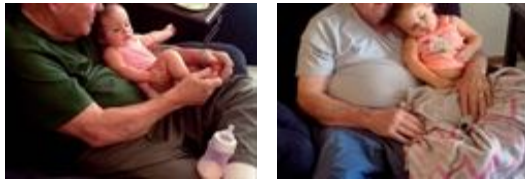

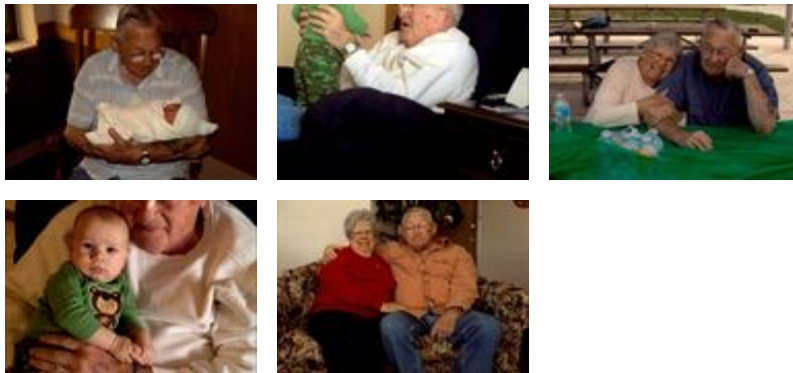
