



## Jose Angel Moreno

August 17, 1939 - September 1, 2024

Jose “Joe” Angel Moreno 85, passed on to the next life September 1, 2024. Joe was born August 17, 1939 in San Antonio, Texas to Jose Angel Moreno Sr and Guadalupe (Rangel), where he was also raised. Joe enlisted and served honorably at the age of 16 years old in the United States Army, serving in the 1st Infantry Division (Big Red 1) in Frankfurt, Germany and Fort Riley, Kansas. Joe would often travel during his weekend passes to Kansas City. While in KC he met Frances Hernandez, they married and raised 6 children in Kansas City’s Westside neighborhood. He was very proud of his military service and could often be seen sporting a First Infantry Division hat. Joe’s faith in God, led him at times to be very involved with Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church, thus earning the Bishop’s Award for Volunteerism. Joe spent his career as a machinist, retiring from York Pharmaceutical, afterward settling in Kansas City, Kansas Argentine neighborhood. He made a host of friends everywhere and was known to flash his smile if he knew you. Over the decades Joe enjoyed visiting with his brothers and sisters whenever he traveled back to San Antonio. He would often tell stories of growing up in the Riverside neighborhood there. Joe enjoyed visits from any one of his 15 grandchildren and would always dote on them. He also has 11 great grandchildren and 3 great-great grandchildren. He was proud of the accomplishments of all his children.
