Loretta June Ramsel, 86, of Kansas City, Kansas passed away January 9th, 2025 at NorthCare Hospice peacefully surrounded by family. A visitation will be held from 10:00-11:00 AM with a Memorial Service beginning at 11:00 AM on Thursday, January 16th, 2025 at Antioch Church. Loretta was born on November 3rd, 1938, in Kansas City, Kansas, to Roscoe and Virginia Anderson. Growing up, she discovered a love for music, dancing and art that would stay with her throughout her life. At Turner High School, she became known for her talent on the dance floor, competing in dance competitions. She found joy in singing, playing the piano, as well as painting. She graduated with the class of 1956, ready to embrace the next chapter of her life. Soon after graduation, on August 4th, 1956, Loretta married Roger Ramsel, the man who would become her lifelong partner. Loretta had a passion for travel and experiencing new cultures and traditions. Together they explored new places, making memories that would last a lifetime. No matter where life took them, they faced each adventure side by side- from Hawaii to Thailand to the Ukraine and more. Her adventures alongside Roger brought new experiences full of growth and new friendships along the way. Although Kansas City, Kansas, remained Loretta's home for most of her life, she and Roger spent time in northern Arizona, where they dedicated themselves to missionary work among the people of the Hopi tribe where many lifelong friendships bloomed. Their shared faith was central to their lives, and their

time in Arizona was a deeply meaningful experience.

Loretta grew up a devoted member of First Baptist Church of Turner where she married Roger. Later in life they found community at Antioch Church.

Loretta's faith was a guiding force in all that she did. She took great pride in raising her family and found peace in her garden, nurturing it with the same care she gave to her loved ones. Loretta's life was filled with love, service, and a deep commitment to her faith, family, and the communities she touched.

She is preceded in death by her parents; a son, Roger D. Ramsel; son-in-law Carlos Ibarra; three siblings, Joel Anderson, Barry Anderson, and Roy Anderson; and sister-in-law Wilma Anderson. She is survived by her husband of 68 years, Roger M. 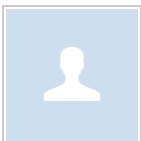
