Mark Raymond Hallisey, age 41, of Kansas City, Missouri passed away Sunday, August 20, 2017 at the North Kansas City Hospital in North Kansas City, Missouri.

Mark was born September 12, 1975 in Kansas City, Kansas, the son of Michael Raymond and Vivian Irene (Toler) Hallisey. Mark spent his childhood laughing and playing with friends and cousins, and was known as the life of the party, even in his youth. Most recently he was serving as project manager for Bridge Turnkey Investments, where he managed the repair and renovation of investment homes. He loved working with tools, building, and fixing things, and he frequently helped family and friends with renovations to their homes. Mark was always helping people and took much joy in making others laugh and feel good. Throughout his entire life, Mark was a big practical jokester, teller of funny stories, and watcher of comedy movies and videos. Mark was also a huge sports fan and was an avid supporter of the Kansas City Chiefs and Royals. Mark's most compassionate work was being a devoted and caring father, son, grandson, brother, uncle, nephew and friend. He loved his family and he loved his friends as if they were his family. His big heart, his laugh, and his warm spirit will always be remembered and will continue on in their lives forever.

He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Calvin and Velma Toler, and Mary DePriest; father, Michael Raymond Hallisey; step-father, Joseph Costanza; and uncle, Wayne Toler. 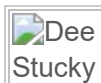

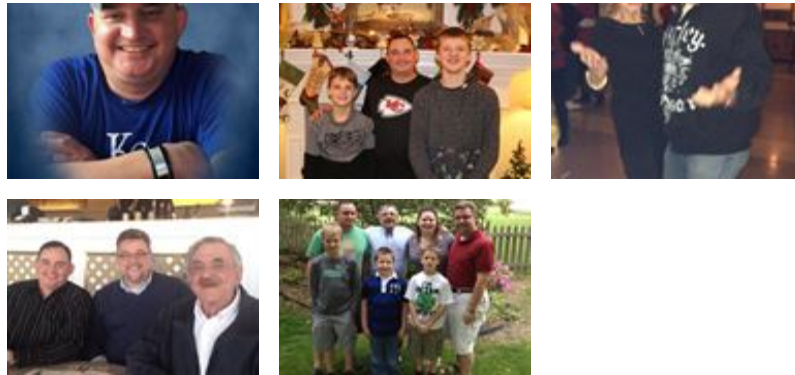

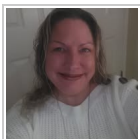
