Matthew "Popo" Reyes III, age 71, passed away on September 28, 2024. Born on May 12, 1953, in Kansas City, Kansas, he was the beloved son of Matthew and Sally Reyes.

A proud graduate of Rosedale High School, Class of 1972, Matthew dedicated 33 years of his life to the United States Postal Service, serving at the Westport branch until his retirement in 2015. Following his retirement, he found joy in working as a school bus monitor for the Shawnee Mission School District for four years.

Matthew married his best friend, Amelia Castilleja, on September 9, 1973, sharing a loving partnership that spanned over five decades. A passionate Kansas City Chiefs fan, he never missed a game and proudly referred to himself as "Chief Mateo." His family affectionately called him "The Drifter," a nod to his adventurous spirit.

An avid enthusiast of low riders, Matthew owned many cars throughout his life and co-founded the car club, The Soul Survivors, with his brothers in the early 1980s, a community that remains active today.

grandchildren, Alicia Reyes and Ruben Reyes II; his siblings, Sally Bialek, Rose Hernandez (Victor), Mary Drake (Wallace), Mark Reyes (Francis), Martin Reyes (Juanita), J.C. Reyes (Rita), and Jimmy Reyes (Roberta); as well as many cherished nieces, nephews, and friends.
