

Ramiro Chavez

March 28, 1932 - December 22, 2022

Ramiro Chavez, 90, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on December 22, 2022. Ramiro, the son of Jose Maria Chavez and Maria Garibay, was born on March 28, 1932 in Tangancicuaro, Michoacan Mexico.

Ramiro started working at 9 years old helping his father on the farm. At 14 he came to the USA, he held many jobs in Arizona, Chicago, Texas, New Mexico, California, and Missouri before settling in Kansas. He resided in the Kansas City Argentine area and worked for Atchison Topeka Santa Fe Railroad for 30 years before retiring in 1997. He loved watching "Los Royales" baseball, boxing "Julio Cesar Chavez", gardening, building structures, and spending time at "El Rancho de Buenos Aires" in Tangancicuaro. He will be remembered for his tremendous work ethic, "famous carnitas", resourcefulness and generosity.

He valued education in hopes that his children would have an easier life than he. He always kept himself busy and lived each day with great spirit and humility. Described by many as hardworking, always willing to help, and a little jokester with those he felt comfortable with. When asked what he wanted to eat he always said, "un T-bone steak" although he also loved his barbeque.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Maria Luz Mendez; son, Francisco; daughter, Lucia; one great grandchild; and both of his parents. We will miss

him greatly but rejoice knowing he is reunited with them.

Ramiro is survived by his sons Jose Luis, David, Ramiro Jr., and Jesus; daughters Maria, Roselia, and Lusía; 15 grandchildren; 19 great grandchildren; brothers Miguel and Herminio; and many friends.

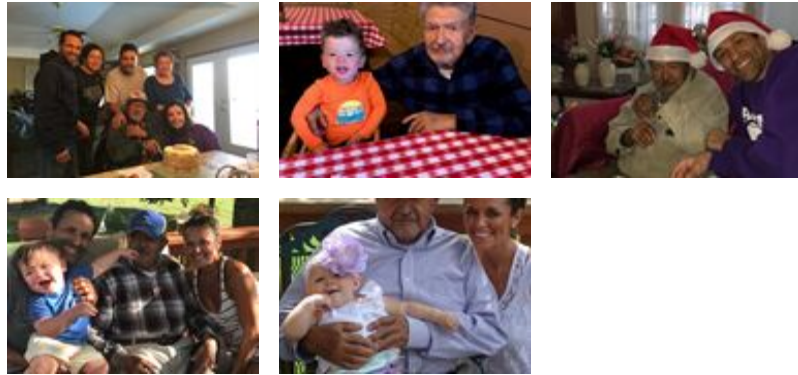

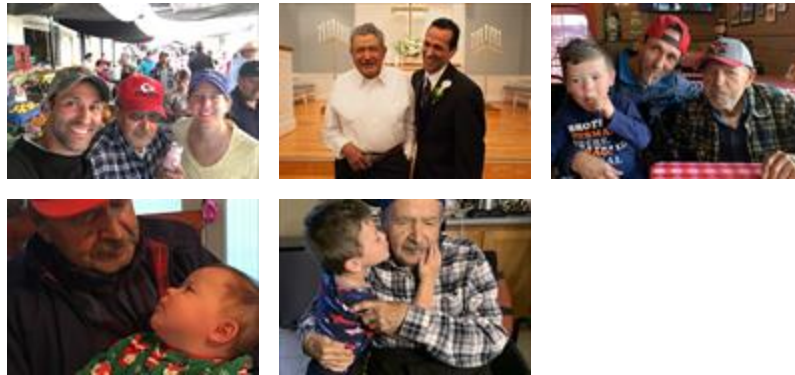
