Raymond Fisher, 91, passed away April 30, 2014 at A New Day at Home after a life well lived. He was surrounded by his loving family. Ray was born on June 4 1922 in Kansas City, KS to William and Margaret Fisher. He graduated from Rosedale High and earned a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering Degree from Finlay Engineering College. He served as Sergeant in the Army signal Corps from 1942-1946, serving time in the Philippines. He married the love of his life, Mary Alyce Church, September 18, 1943 and had three sons Stephen, Robert, and Jeffrey. He became a member of the IBEW in 1947 and worked with his stepfather, the late Charles Bachman, at the Bachman Electric Company. He started R.F. Fisher Electric Company in 1965, which he built into a successful company. He was a respected member of the National Electrical Contractors Association and served as a director. He sold his business in 1988 and retired. He was a devoted member of Roanoke Presbyterian Church and served as trustee. Ray enjoyed spending time at the Lake of the Ozarks with his family. Preceding him in death were his parents, his sister Winifred Runions, one step sister, two stepbrothers and his wife of 60 years. He is survived by his three devoted sons Stephen (Jim), Bob (Julie), and Jeff (Sherri); grandchildren Leslie White (Tom), Tyson, Jay (Brenda), Kristen, Lindsey, and Bennett; great granddaughter Addison; step grandchildren Connie, Tony and Krista; step-great grandson Zane.
