Robert (Bob) D. Johnson, Jr., 83, passed away peacefully into the arms of his Savior, Jesus Christ, on February 12, 2025, surrounded by his wife, Judy, and family.

Bob was born in Pleasant Hill, Missouri, to Robert Dean (R.D.) Johnson and Marguerite Windmiller Johnson on June 26, 1941. Bob married his “True Love,” Judith (Judy) Anderson, on August 27, 1960, in Columbia, Missouri. The two shared a blessed and loving marriage for 64 ½ years. Bob was preceded in death by his parents.
