



## Robert Calvin Bray Sr.

December 31, 1924 - May 4, 2013

Robert Calvin Bray, born December 31, 1924 passed away May 4th at St. Luke's Heart Institute, he was 88 years old. He worked at Procter & Gamble for 28 years. He was a proud Navy veteran and fought in World War II while serving on the USS Missouri as a gunners mate 2nd class. He witnessed the signing of the peace treaty between the United States and Japan. After the peace signing he was part of a military detail sent to a silver mine in Missouri to pick up the silver that was used to make the commemorative plaque of the peace signing that is mounted on the deck of the USS Missouri. He was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth Pauline Harrison, married 58 years, and two of their four sons Robert Calvin Bray, Jr. and Roger Evan Bray. They lived in the Argentine area while raising 4 very active boys. As a family they enjoyed going to their cabin at the Lake of the Ozarks and for years attending all the sporting events the boys were involved in. They always enjoyed getting together for special occasions and holidays being surrounded by their children, grandchildren and great- grandchildren. He was a life long member at Grace Assembly church. Calvin is survived by sons, Richard Dean Bray, (DeeAnna Bray), Raymond Brian Bray,(Connie Bray), 6 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. He also leaves a brother Frank Bray. Services will be Wednesday, May 8th at Maple Hill Funeral Home, with visitation from 10:00-11:00, with services starting at 11:00. Burial at Maple Hill Cemetery.
