Robert Lee Brendlinger was born September 25, 1947 to E. Ruth (Sapp) Brendlinger and Willis C. Brendlinger. He grew up in Exeter MO, graduating high school at Exeter HS in 1965 as valedictorian of his class. He earned a BS in Chemistry from SW MO State. He earned his MBA at UMKC and a MDiv at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Robert married Carla Bowman in 1967, daughter Amy was born in 1970. They moved to Kansas City in 1971 (due to Amy's medical issues) where he assumed a position as Industrial Hygienist at Bendix Corporation. After earning his MBA, Robert started his own market research company. The company enjoyed good success counting the Kansas City Chiefs among its clients.

As time went on Robert's heart was called to the ministry resulting in him pursuing a Divinity degree. The rest of his life was dedicated to the ministry, he held positions at Colonial Presbyterian church and the Johnson County Baptist Association.

It brought him great joy to donate a kidney to his daughter, Amy. He was always a loving and devoted father.

In 2007, Robert met the love of his life, Dianna Ruth, who he married on June

12, 2010. At that time, Robert was blessed with becoming a father to her 3 children.
