Robert Antonio Felix, Sr. 89, of Kansas City, Kansas, passed away on January 5, 2025, at Olathe Health Hospice House. He was born on October 6, 1935, in Kansas City, Kansas, to Antonio and Mildred Felix. On March 19, 1955, Robert married the love of his life, Kay, and together they raised six children. He was baptized at First Christian Church in Armourdale and was an active member of Oak Grove Christian Church. A proud Mason, Robert served as Master of the Armourdale Masonic Lodge #271 in both 1976 and 1992. Robert worked as a city trucker for Gillette Motor Transport (Roadway) and retired in June 1989 after many years of dedicated service.
