Robert L. Pendleton, 71, of Kansas City, KS passed away on Saturday, October 7, 2017, at Kansas City Hospice House. Bob was born on March 1, 1946 in Monett, Mo. He graduated from Shawnee Mission East High School in 1964 and on October 22, 1965 married his wife of 51 years, Linda. Upon returning from a short, 4-day honeymoon, his draft papers were waiting for him. He proudly served in the Army in the 4th Infantry Division returning from Vietnam in 1967.

Bob returned from Vietnam to a lifelong profession as a carpenter, having retired from the Kansas City Kansas Public Schools in 2009. In the early years after returning from Vietnam, he enjoyed life working on his parents farm and riding horses. After his parents sold their farm, his hobbies became riding Harleys and trikes; playing Texas Hold-em; traveling with his son and grandson; and sitting in his gazebo. Above all these, he enjoyed and loved his family.

Bob was preceded in death by his sons, Scott R. Pendleton and Shane M. Pendleton; parents, Dick and Kate Pendleton; his sisters, Linda and Sylvia; and his brother, Wayne. He is survived by his wife, Linda Overton Pendleton; son, Dr. Steven (Amy) Pendleton, grandsons Dylan and Miguel Pendleton,

granddaughters Emily Pendleton, Brittney (Billy) Atwood, Mallory (Brian) Tillman, and Lena Pendleton, and six beautiful great-grandchildren, and host of other family and friends.
