Ronald Alan "Tiny" Greer, 74, of Kansas City, passed peacefully from his earthly home Saturday, December 3, 2016 surrounded by his family at the Kansas City Hospice House. 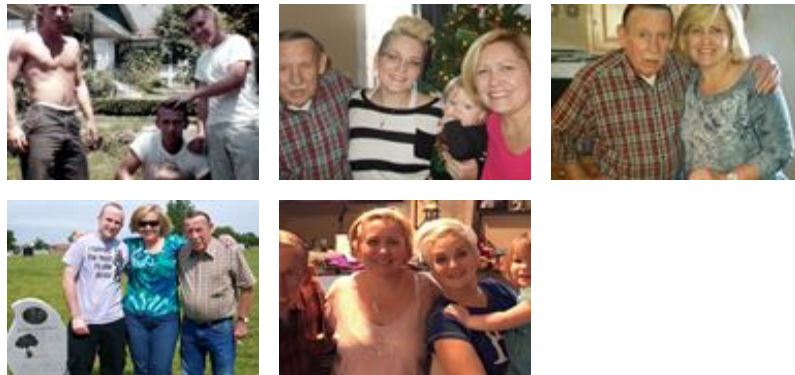
