“ We were all well fed.

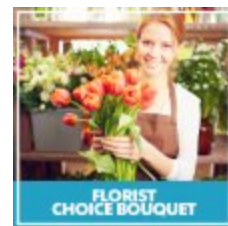

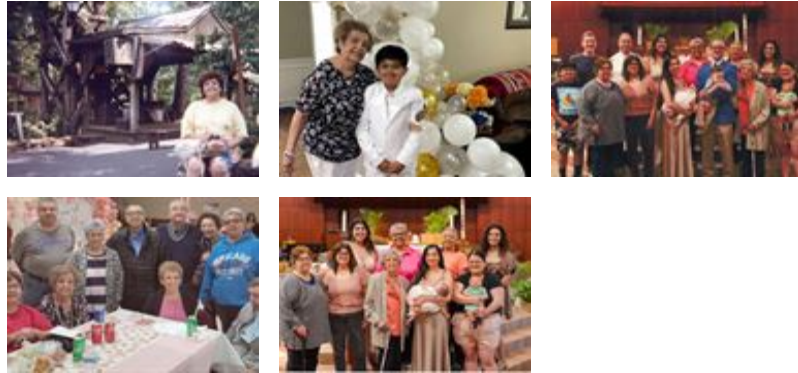
