Terry was born on March 19, 1955, in Kansas City, Kansas, to Bertha M. Cade (Jones) and Dr. Andre' Renaud, and was later adopted by Walter E. Cade Sr.

He grew up in Kansas City, graduated from De La Salle High School, and proudly served in the United States Army, earning the National Defense Service Medal and an Honorable Discharge.

While stationed in Frankfurt, Germany, he met and later married Anna, and together they welcomed their son, Terry A. Cade Jr.

Terry Sr. later became the father of Solomon Jackson, Edwin Jackson (with Aretha Jackson), and Nalesha Cade (with Michelle Buckner).

Terry worked in auto sales, retired from Toyota after his MS diagnosis, and served as an ordained minister at St. Peter's AME Church. Known for his comedian-like humor, love of barbeque, and self proclaimed status of the Kansas City Chiefs#1 fan, he brought laughter everywhere he went.
