March 21, 1954 - March 19, 2025

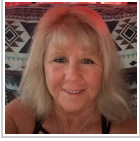

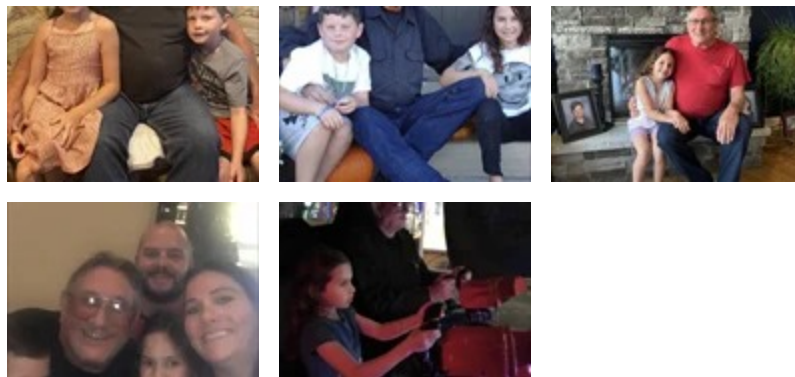

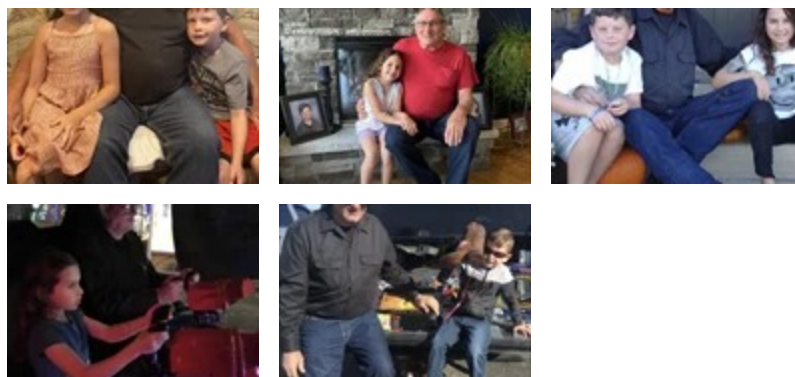
