



William "Bill" Carl Rumble

August 6, 1930 - March 26, 2019

William Carl Rumble, of Overland Park, KS, passed away on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 at the age of 88. Bill was born August 6, 1930 in rural Ohio, where he grew up with his three siblings. Shortly thereafter, he joined the Air Force, met his beloved Trudy in Germany and they were married for 63 years till the day she died in 2017. Bill and Trudy raised their family in Germany, California, New Mexico and Colorado. They settled in Wichita, KS where he retired after 20 years of military service, enjoying sailing, camping and fishing with his family. In 1989 Trudy and Bill moved to Eugene, OR, where he enjoyed gardening, woodworking, camping and salmon fishing. They spent their last years near family in Kansas City.

Many would call this an unremarkable life, but Bill served his country, was devoted to his family, and was a compassionate caregiver for Trudy. Bill was a friend to anyone he met.

Survivors include his two sons, Bruce (Debra), Mark (Ivri); daughter, Diane (Hermann); five grandchildren, Bryson, Megan, Markus, Marcel, and Maya; three great-grandchildren and a loving extended family. 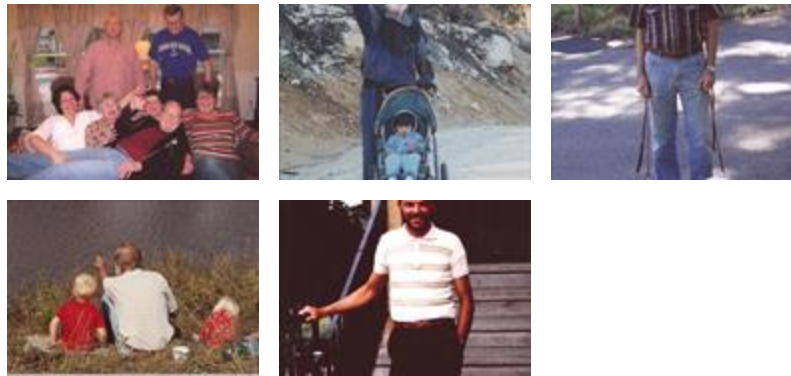

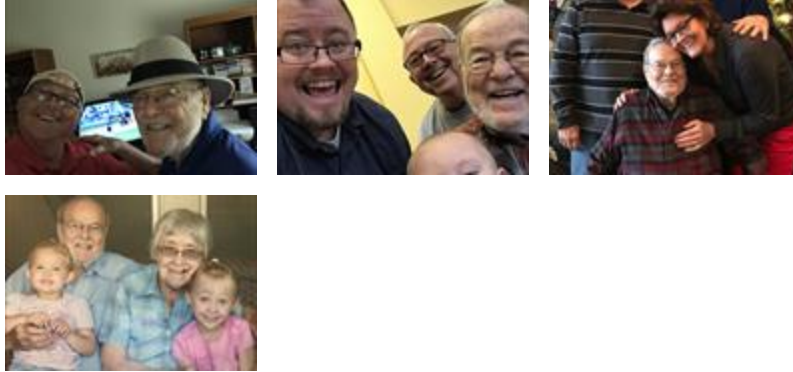
