William Robert (Bob) Stirling, 90, of KCK, passed away February 19, 2015 at Garden Terrace Overland Park. Funeral services will be held 2 p.m. Monday, February 23, at Maple Hill Funeral Home, with visitation from 12:30 to 2:00 before the service. Burial will be in Maple Hill Cemetery. Bob was a lifelong KCK resident and co-owner of Stirling Auto Supply in Argentine, Kansas. From 1942 to 1946 Bob served his country in World War II, serving both in the US Navy and US Marine Corps. Survivors include his 3 daughters, Debbie Stockman of Overland Park, KS; Becky Russell and Kathy Day (husband Brad), both of Shawnee, KS; eight grandchildren; fourteen great-grandchildren. He also leaves behind his brother Jim Stirling and sister-in-law Ann Stirling; and other extended family. His family gives thanks to Garden Terrace for the loving care provided to Bob. Sweet Ole' Bob lived each day to its fullest and encouraged everyone to do the same. He will be missed by all whose lives were touched with his warm smile and positive attitude.
